The carpenter-fitter's job is a very meticulous one. He **adjusts, fits and finalises onboard woodwork**: furniture, floors, and the overall structure. **His job begins when construction starts**, once the hull is finished.

The first phase involves **laying the main structure**, i.e. the primary ribbing (lateral and longitudinal reinforcements) up to the bulkheads. The second phase is dedicated to **fitting furniture and floors up to the deck of the boat**. This is a meticulous **process**, and it takes time. The third phase is devoted to the finishing touches and is managed by another team.
